Estimated Total Cost (Independent Applicant)

Items		Fees (KRW)	Fees (approx USD)
Tuition (incl. Trips/Activities)		2,400,000	2,200
Housing (New Dormitory)	2 bedroom	680,000	625

- ◆ Meals cost KRW 400,000 (~400USD) and books cost KRW 50,000 (~50USD) approximately
- ◆ Students who apply independently (non-sister university/non-ISEP students) pay tuition and trip/activities fees directly to Ajou University by May 31
- ◆ For applicants applying to AISS from Ajou University's partner universities or ISEP, students can join AISS as an exchange student. Tuition is waived for the students of Ajou's partner universities and for ISEP students, trips & activities fees and housing are also waived.
- ◆ Non-exchange students from partner universities can join AISS with 50% tuition. Please, contact your home coordinator at an international office for the details.
