贵州大学孔子学院奖学金

本奖学金是由孔子学院总部(国家汉办)设立的资助外国学生、学者和汉语教师到贵州大学进修汉语言文学的全额奖学金。从 2010 年至今,贵州大学已接收来自 22 个国家的 100 名孔子学院奖学金学生。

奖学金类别及申请条件

本年度招生类别是一学年研修生和一学期研修生。招生对象为非中国籍人士,身体健康,年龄一般在 16 至 35 周岁之间(在职汉语教师可放宽至 45 周岁)。 学习专业为汉语言文学。

- 一**学年研修生** 资助期限为 11 个月。面向孔子学院(课堂)学员,海外本土汉语教师、中文专业学生、HSK 考试成绩优秀者,不招收在华留学生。汉语水平不低于 HSK 三级 180 分、HSKK 初级 60 分,<u>或者</u>不低于 BCT(A)180 分、BCT(口语)180 分。
- 一学期研修生 资助期限为 5 个月。申请者无来华留学经历,汉语水平不低于 HSK 二级 120 分、HSKK 初级 40 分,<u>或者</u>不低于 BCT (A) 100 分、BCT (口语) 120 分。

奖学金内容

- 免注册费、学费;
- 提供免费校内住宿;
- 提供生活费人民币 2500 元/月;
- 提供留学生综合医疗保险。

申请与录取

I. 2016 年 5 月 10 日前,申请者登陆孔子学院奖学金网站(http://cis.chinese.cn) 注册个人账号,填写《孔子学院奖学金申请表》并上传有关证明材料的电子扫描件。需要准备的材料包括:

- 电子照片
- 护照照片页扫描件:
- HSK、HSKK 或 BCT、BCT (口语) 成绩报告。申请人如为"汉语桥"复赛获奖者,提供"汉语桥"获奖证书和"孔子学院奖学金证书"后,可以不再提供 HSK、HSKK 或 BCT、BCT (口语) 成绩报告;
- 申请陈述(用中文介绍汉语学习背景、来华学习计划及目标等);
- 推荐机构负责人签发的推荐信(评价申请者并注明是否为孔子学院学员或 其它身份)。在职汉语教师申请须提交就职机构出具的在职证明和推荐信;
- 最高学历证明或在读证明;
- 个人签名扫描件;

请注意:

- ◆ 请在推荐机构的指导下准备各项申请材料;
- ◆ 请如实填写所有内容,提交申请前,确认申请奖学金类别、申请学习时间、申请院校及专业填写正确;
- ◆ 电子照片和个人签名扫描件的上传文件需小于 300KB, 其他电子扫描件需小于 2M。所有文件格式须为 "*.jpg/*.gif/*.bmp/*.jpeg"。
- II. 申请人提交网上申请后,应请求相关推荐机构及时审核申请人资格及申请材料,并对符合要求的申请进行确认和推荐。为保证后续录取流程顺利开展以及入学材料及时办理,各推荐机构请在 2016 年 5 月 20 日前在奖学金系统内完成推荐工作。
- III. 汉办确认申请材料有效后,贵州大学审核申请人的入学资格,并向汉办提交 预录取名单。汉办综合评审录取后,贵州大学将在 7 月中旬将《录取通知书》、《报到须知》、《外国留学人员来华签证申请表》(JW202 表)等相关入学材料 寄达推荐机构或奖学金获得者本人。

Guizhou University Confucius Institute Scholarship

This program is a full scholarship program sponsored by Confucius Institute Headquarters (or "Hanban") to support foreign students, scholars and Chinese language teachers to study Chinese Language and Literature at Guizhou University (GZU). Since 2010, a number of 100 students have enrolled at Guizhou University under Confucius Institute Scholarships.

Categories of Scholarship and Eligibility

The 2016 Confucius Institute Scholarship offered by Guizhou University includes Scholarships for One-Academic-Year Study Students and Scholarships for One-Semester Study Students. Applicants shall be non-Chinese citizens in good health, aged between 16 and 35 (Chinese language teachers in post shall be aged below 45). The field of study (specialty) is Chinese Language and Literature.

- Scholarship for One-Academic-Year Study Students: This category provides a sponsorship for 11 months. Application is open to Confucius Institute (Classroom) students, overseas Chinese language teachers, Chinese language major students and excellent performers in HSK test. International students who are now studying in China are not eligible for the scholarship. Applicant should have a minimum score of 180 in HSK Test (Level 3), and 60 in HSKK test (Beginner Level), or have a minimum score of 180 in BCT (A), and a minimum score of 180 BCT (Speaking).
- Scholarship for One-Semester Study Students: This category provides a sponsorship
 for 5 months. Applicant should have no prior experience of studying in China, but have a
 minimum score of 120 in HSK Test (Level 2), and a minimum score of 40 in HSKK
 (Beginner Level), or have a minimum score of 100 in BCT (A), and a minimum score of
 120 in BCT (Speaking).

Scholarship Coverage

- a waiver of fee for registration and tuition
- free on-campus dormitory accommodation
- CNY 2,500 monthly living allowance
- outpatient medical service and comprehensive medical insurance

Application and Enrollment

1. Applicants shall visit the Confucius Institute Scholarship website at http://cis.chinese.cn, set up an individual account, fill out the Scholarship

Application Form online accurately, upload the required documents, and submit the Application before the deadline **May 10**. Such documents should be prepared:

- Digital photo
- Valid passport front-page photocopy;
- HSK, HSKK or BCT, BCT (Speaking) score reports. Winners of the finals of the "Chinese Bridge" Chinese Proficiency Competitions may submit the certificate of scholarship instead;
- Application statement (a paragraph written in Chinese that states the applicant's study background, plan and purpose of studying in China)
- Recommendation letter signed by the head of the recommending institutions (objective comments on the applicant, including whether the applicant is a student of Confucius Institute or other identity).
- Highest educational certificate or current student certificate
- Scanning copy of personal signature


Note:

- please prepare the application under the guidance of the Recommending Institute;
- please provide information and materials faithfully, and make sure the application details such as scholarship category, institution, study duration and study specialty are accurate;
- The files of digital photo and personal signature uploaded should be smaller than 300 KB, and the other uploaded files should be less than 2 MB. All files should be in "*.jpg/*.gif/*.bmp/*.jpeg" format.
- 2. After successful online application and uploading of materials, the applicant should request the recommending institutes to review and recommend the application. For later admission procedures and timely preparation of enrollment materials, we request all recommending institutes to finish recommending applications in the Scholarship System before May 20.
- 3. When the applications are verified by Hanban, GZU will examine the qualification of the candidates and send an admission list for Hanban's approval. Hanban will decide the final list of scholarship winners. GZU will forward the Letter of Acceptance, Tips on Registration, JW202 Visa Application Form and other enrollment materials to the recommending institution or directly to the scholarship winners in July.

贵州大学位于贵州省省会、中国西南地区重要中心城市一贵阳市。贵阳是云贵高原上一颗闪耀的明珠,平均海拔 1000 米左右,冬无严寒、夏无酷暑,夏季平均温度为 19℃-26℃,有"爽爽的贵阳"之称;喀斯特地貌分布广泛,占全市国土面积的 85%,形成了峰林、溶沟、峡谷、溶洞为一体的绚丽景观;森林覆盖率达 41.78%,是中国首个"国家森林城市";汉、苗、布依、仡佬等 17 个世居民族和谐共荣,形成了五彩缤纷的民族文化"大观园"。

GUIZHOU UNIVERSITY is located in Guiyang, the capital city of Guizhou Province and a major city in southwestern China. Guiyang is dubbed "a shinning pearl" on the Yunnan-Guizhou Plateau. With an average altitude of 1,000 meters, the City is known for its agreeable warm winter and cool summer, with the summer temperature hovering between 19 to 26 degrees Celsius. The Karst landscapes account for more than 85% of the total area of the City, characterizing spectacular scenes of peak clusters, canyons, valleys and caves. The 41.78% high forest coverage makes Guiyang the first "National Forest City" and the "Natural Oxygen Bar" of China. Seventeen long-dwelling ethnic minorities including Miao, Bouyei and Gelao have been co-prospering here in harmony, forming a magnificent view of multifarious blooming ethnic cultures.
