### ***Curriculum Vitae: Arwin Nimis***

Arwin Nimis, (1971, MA, University of Twente) is managing director of the Staff Office Marketing & Communication of Hanze University Groningen, University of Applied Sciences. Hanze University is one of the largest (over 20,000 students) and most all-round (technology, fine arts, music, technology, etc.) universities of applied sciences in the Netherlands. He is responsible for enrolment management, public affairs, strategic and corporate communication of the university. He is a member of boards and advisory bodies of several NGO's (local TV-network, housing organisation). As a freelance-consultant he served for CHEPS (Center of Higher Education and Policy Studies). Nimis studied public administration at the University of Twente. He has been a member of the University Council. After his graduation in 1995 he worked as a consultant in the public health sector focussing on cost efficiency and commercialisation of care products. Thereafter he returned to the University of Twente to work as a deputy director of the Policy Department and as a registrar of the Board of Governors and the Supervisory Board. From 2001 to 2006 he was the managing director (and a spokesman) of the Communications Department of the University of Twente, a small but high level research university in the eastern part of the Netherlands.
