## About the Program

Reorganized in 2005, the ISS has been receiving an increased amount of funds from the Seoul Metropolitan Government and offers various incentives to participants coming from UOS partner universities and many other prestigious universities all over the world.

## Specialties of the Program

UOS offers a buddy program "Seoul Mate" for international students. The Seoul Mates are UOS Korean students who help international students adjust to life in Korea. The Seoul Mates live with the international students at the dorm, and participate in most of the programs offered by the ISS with all of the international students.

A 4-day field trip to Jeju Island in Korea, a volcanic island full of allure with breathtaking natural beauty as well as World Heritage Sites by UNESCO, will give you a better understanding about Korea.

### ★ Various Field Trips and Cultural Activities!

To learn about Korea's past, present and future, you can experience various kinds of activities while visiting meaningful spots in Korea such as Changdeok Palace (UNESCO World Heritage), Jeonju

Hanok Village, and the JSA (Joint Security Area) or DMZ (Demilitarized Zone). Activities like learning Taekwondo (Korean martial arts) & K-Pop Dance, making Korean traditional masks, or watching a NANTA Show will create unforgettable memories as well.

## Admission Requirements

- \* Undergraduates or Postgraduates from all over the world are eligible for the program.
- \* UOS International Summer School accepts exchange students from partner universities.

### ★ Application Process

**Step 1** If the applications are from UOS partner universities, their home universities' International Offices are asked to nominate their students via email to [uossummer@uos.ac.kr](mailto:uossummer@uos.ac.kr) from **March 1 to April 30, 2016**.

**Step 2** Each of the applicants is required to complete **the on-line application** (at <http://global.uos.ac.kr> --> For International Students --> Studying in UOS --> International Summer School --> Eligibility & Application) from **March 1 to April 30, 2016**.

**Step 3** UOS issues the admission letter and invoice, which will be emailed (or mailed if needed) to each applicant and to his/her home university's International Office of the applicant on exchange.
