If the applications are from UOS partner universities, their home universities' International Offices are asked to nominate their students via email to <a href="mailto:uossummer@uos.ac.kr">uossummer@uos.ac.kr</a> from March 1 to April 30, 2016.



Each of the applicants is required to complete the on-line application (at http://global.uos. ac.kr --> For International Students --> Studying in UOS --> International Summer School --> Eligibility & Application) from March 1 to April 30, 2016.



UOS issues the admission letter and invoice, which will be emailed (or mailed if needed) to each applicant and to his/her home university's International Office of the applicant on exchange
