STUDIES:

- The faculty offers unique interdisciplinary and integrated study programmes that combine content creation, communication, management, and creativity.

- The faculty cooperates with business companies, leaders of the Lithuanian public and private sector: LRT, the French Institute of Lithuania, Etaplus, National Library of Lithuania, Office of the Equal Opportunities Ombudsperson.
