Student Exchange Programme	
Semester	Fall Semester – Early September to late December (including exam) Spring Semester – Jan to late May (including exam)
Application Method	HSUHK will only accept exchange students who have been nominated by partner institutions. Students are required to complete HSUHK Admission Form and submit relevant documents to HSUHK via partner institutions.
Nomination & Application Deadline	Fall Semester – Early to mid-April Spring Semester – Mid-October to late October
Language Requirements	Applicants are required to complete at least one term of study in home institution and attain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) or equivalent. For those who are not native English speakers, they are required to possess one of the following qualifications: <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ a minimum score of 550 (paper-based)/213 (computer-based)/79 (internet-based) or above in TOFEL; or■ a minimum score of 6 or above in IELTS Proof of language capacity may be satisfied if the student has completed substantial university-level course work in English.
Useful Information	
Course Registration	Students are required to complete 12 credit-units (or 4 courses) min. to 18 credit-units (or 6 courses) max. No specific course restrictions are applied but students are advised to check pre-requisite(s) of individual subjects. Exchange students can select courses from different programmes as long as the timetable allows. HSUHK would provide students the course list in November and May each year. Accommodation	Places in Residential College on campus are reserved for students. HSUHK would invite students to submit application in November and June.
Estimated Living Cost	Accommodation: ranged from HK\$1,600 to HK\$1,800 per month, depend on the choice of the room. Meals: around HK\$3,000 per month Books: around HK\$1,000 per semester Personal Expenses: around HK\$1,500 per month Actual expenses depend on your personal spending habit
Health Insurance	Students are required to purchase insurance and submit proof of insurance coverage prior to arrival. The insurance must cover travel, personal accidents, medical expenses (accident and non-accident), hospitalization and emergency evacuation/repatriation.
Buddy Programme	Available and airport pick-up will be arranged by a Buddy.
Orientation	All incoming exchange students are required to attend the Orientation which usually take place a week before the beginning of the semester.
