Purpose of the course unit		
The main objectives of the module: a) to develop students' conversational and comprehension skills in Italian (corresponding to level A2); b) to form a competence to analyze a number of model texts of Italian literature; c) to conceive of the impact of phenomenological and hermeneutical approaches on European language education with a special focus on Italian literature; d) to gain understanding of the peculiarities of the development of Italian literature; e) to develop analytical and critical thinking.

The students will - acquire the relevant knowledge about a number of important texts of Italian literature; - acquire certain conversational and comprehension skills (corresponding to level A2-B1); - be able to analyse a number of model Italian literary texts in a broader context of European literature and culture with a reference to classical and most recent achievements in the theory of literature; - conceive of the peculiarities of the development of Italian literature; - be able to work in a group, to take part in the discussion and offer their arguments; - acquire public speaking skills.	Various techniques developed by communicative, audio-lingual and other methods of language teaching. Problem-focused teaching, text analysis, discussions. Reading scientific and literary texts, analysing and commenting them. Autonomous work of students.	Cumulative score: estimation of work during the seminars and delivered presentations – 25%, writing of paraphrases and essays – 25%, oral examination – 50%.
