Aim of module: competences developed by the study programme

This course introduces Mandarin Chinese to beginners with no prior knowledge of the language. Students will learn Chinese tones, the *pinyin* spelling system, and characters. They will develop A1-level listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills, alongside an understanding of the language's basic structure. By the end of the course, students will be able to engage in basic daily conversations.

Students will be able to identify and pronounce Chinese tones and syllables using the <i>pinyin</i> system and to understand the tonal nature of the language.	Phonetic drills, practice	End of term oral exam, student
Students will engage in simple structured conversations on everyday topics, such as greetings, introductions, interests, and basic needs. Applying essential vocabulary and sentence patterns.	Active listening, practice, active (self-)studying methods (role plays, dialogue performances)	presentation
Students will recognize and write a foundational set of Chinese characters, understanding their basic structure and stroke order, and relate them to corresponding <i>pinyin</i> and meanings.	Texts' reading, practice	End of term exam, (multiple choice and writing), homeworks
Students will gain cultural awareness by understanding the norms and traditions that shape Mandarin Chinese communication. They will learn the importance of respectful language, culturally appropriate expressions, and gestures in various social settings. The course will also introduce key aspects of Chinese festivals, customs, and values, providing students with the context needed to communicate effectively and appropriately in real-life situations.
