Students will be able to engage in extended conversations on familiar topics, expressing opinions, preferences, and experiences with increased fluency and accuracy, while using a wider range of vocabulary and sentence structures appropriate to intermediate-level communication. Students will gain cultural awareness by understanding the norms and traditions that shape Mandarin Chinese communication. They will learn the importance of respectful language, culturally appropriate expressions, and gestures in various social settings.
