Annotation of the course content
<p>Word formation and it's relationship with other branches of linguistics: synchronic and diachronic word formation, word formation and morphology, phonology, lexicology, syntax. Derivatives, compounds and simple words. Derivational opposition and direction: semantic and formal basis, levels of binary analysis of formations, criteria for determining the direction of derivation. Non-repeated morphemes and bound stems. The relationship of word formation analysis with the linguistic methods of immediate constituents, transformation, substitution, statistics, etc. The difference between derivational and morphemic analysis. Derivational meaning and form: types of derivational semantics, difference from lexical meaning, basis of word formation and basic stem, stem disintegration, word formation formant, role of sound and prosodic changes in word formation processes. Word formation system: derivational type, it's regularity and productivity, derivational category (class) and processes of word formation. Problems of semantic-syntactic classification of compounds. Word formation from the perspective of Onomasiology, Cognitive Linguistics, Natural Morphology, Optimality Theory.</p>
