STUDIES

- Bachelor's and Master's study programmes in Economics, Business, Management, Finance, Accounting, Human Resources, and Marketing. Two PhD programmes in **Economics** and **Management**.
- In 2025, a total of 16 Bachelor's and Master's programmes are offered, including 5 Bachelor's and 7 Master's programmes taught in English.
- Courses are delivered by highly qualified professors, leading Lithuanian scholars, business practitioners, and visiting lecturers from abroad.
- CFA® affiliation Master in Finance and Banking aligned with CFA Institute standards.
- ACCA accreditation Master in Accounting and Financial Management grants exam exemptions and international recognition.
- Double-degree opportunities with universities in Spain, France, and Italy across 4 Bachelor's and Master's programmes.
- Since 2020, the Faculty's **Tech Hub Pre-accelerator**: 220+ startups created, >€4M investments attracted, and in 2023, 73 active startups generated >€10M revenue.
- 120 Erasmus+ and bilateral exchange agreements for global mobility.

RESEARCH

- Based on the expert evaluation, the Faculty's economics research field has been recognized as a leader in Lithuania.
- In 2024, two state-of-the-art labs were launched the Consumer Behaviour Lab (CDM LAB) and the Economic Behaviour Lab (VU LABBE) - the only ones of their kind in the Baltics.
- The Faculty hosts a **Bloomberg laboratory** that provides unlimited opportunities for finance and economics research.
- A strategic partnership between the **Bank of Lithuania** and the Faculty is being developed to strengthen research in the fields of economics and finance.
- Host of prestigious international conferences: EuroMed Academy of Business, World Banking and Finance Symposium (2023), and the AMS World Marketing Congress (2026).
- Ongoing scientific projects under Horizon Europe, Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions, EEA and Norway Grants, and the Research Council of Lithuania (LMT).
