STUDIES:

- An exceptional integrated study programme in law: upon completion, students are immediately awarded a master's degree and acquire the right to work in their field.
- The most highly qualified lecturers working as supreme court judges, prosecutors, lawyers, and in international institutions.
- Internship opportunities in various institutions, such as the Supreme Court of Lithuania, the Prosecutor General's Office, as well as in the private sector. There is an opportunity to do an internship at the VU Legal Clinic and thus help socially vulnerable people.
- Students have the opportunity to participate in court staging competitions.
- Developed cooperation with social partners, including all the most famous Lithuanian law firms, courts of all instances, the Prosecutor's Office, the Chamber of Notaries, the Bailiffs Chamber, and major Lithuanian companies (banks, insurance companies).
- Active activities of the Faculty Alumni Association - alumni actively participate in mentoring programmes. Developed practical tutoring activities.

RESEARCH:

- The faculty's researcher and the results thereof are used to make decisions on the adoption or amendment of legislation.
- The faculty participates in international networks of researchers: the International Network of Doctoral Studies in Law, NOHA Association.
- Currently, the faculty pays a lot of attention to the green course and the latest technologies, their impact on the legal system.
