PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The objective

The objective of the programme is to prepare highly qualified managers and leaders processing universal knowledge of quality management, who would know and apply quality management principles and methods in various fields of activity, would be able to recognize and analyse quality related problems, search for the ways to solve them, and implement sound solutions of quality improvement in the dynamic environment. The strengths of the programme are that it:

- has the curriculum that is in line with the curricula of similar programmes at Western universities;
- is delivered by a cohesive team of teachers;
- provides strong skills and deep knowledge of quality management;
- has strong links with business.

In 2015 and 2017, <u>EDUNIVERSAL Global Ranking</u> ranked Quality Management programme in 8th place out of 200 top master's degree programmes in General Management in Eastern Europe; in 2019 - in the 10th place out of 30 top master's degree programmes in Quality Management in the world.

According to the data of official surveys, more than 98 percent of programme students and graduates would recommend programme to others.

During the international accreditation conducted by the Centre for Quality Assessment in Higher Education in 2005 and 2013 Quality Management programme received positive evaluation and was accredited for the maximum period of 6 years.

Career opportunities

A graduate of the programme will be qualified to work as a quality manager, quality auditor, process manager, Lean expert, EFQM assessor and expert of ISO and other standards, to work as a consultant, to continue studies on a doctoral level.

Access to further studies

Vilnius University created opportunities for students interested in continuing their education to enter the doctoral studies, which are available in English language; the best of our graduates might be offered employment at the university.

Programme is designed to give knowledge and practical experience preparing students for the future work in quality management. Learning outcomes of the programme reflect EU Quality policy and are harmonized with EOQ (European Organization for Quality) competence requirements for quality management specialists.

- Ability to design, implement and integrate organizational management systems;
- Ability to integrate advanced business and quality management practices and use them solving organizational problems;
- Ability to conduct the assessment and improvement of organization's performance.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION CRITERIA
