APPLICATION AND SELECTION REQUIREMENTS

- University Bachelor degree in the fields of Social Sciences (Economics) or Business and Management Sciences (Business, Public Administration).
- In case the applicant does not have Bachelor degree in required fields, he/she has to take bridge courses
 and pass required exams (20 ECTS) in the fields of Economics, Management and Business
 Administration or Social Sciences or to support acquired analogous practical 3-year experience with the
 proper documents.
- Required level of English B2 or higher (please refer to CEFR).
