2 General reasons for wanting to participate in the "Vulcanus in professional development – e.g. Why Japan?

Japan" programme: Why Vulcanus? What makes you/your personality suited to Vulcanus?

Specific goals with regard to the different parts of the programme:
seminar about Japan language course

company traineeship: What can you learn? What can you offer?

Compulsory document no. 4 RECOMMENDATION LETTER by a professor of one of your major topics

The document should include:

- original signature of the professor (no scan)
- contact details of the professor (title / email / telephone)
- stamp of professor or of university whenever possible.
