THE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ADMISSION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS TO FIRST CYCLE, SECOND CYCLE, AND INTEGRATED STUDY PROGRAMMES OF VILNIUS UNIVERSITY

1. Foreign nationals who wish to study in study programmes with the Lithuanian language of instruction and foreign nationals who wish to study in first cycle, second cycle, and integrated study programmes with the foreign language of instruction in non-State-funded student places shall be admitted following the Description of the Procedure for the Admission of Foreign Nationals to First Cycle, Second Cycle, and Integrated Study Programmes of Vilnius University.

2. Specific requirements mean additional admission criteria that must be met, along with the general requirements, to apply to the chosen study programme. These requirements shall be established on an annual basis at the core academic units (hereinafter the 'Units') of Vilnius University (hereinafter the 'University') by the councils of the respective Units upon proposal from the heads of these Units or their authorised persons. The specific requirements shall be approved by the Pro-Rector for Studies of the University upon proposal from the Student Admissions Subdivision of the Study Quality and Development Division of the University's Central Administration and shall be published on the University's website (<https://www.vu.lt/en>).

3. Applicants to the first cycle, second cycle, and integrated study programmes of the University must provide a copy of the document certifying their level of proficiency in the language of instruction in the study programme:

3.1. If the language of instruction in the chosen study programme is English, and unless otherwise specified in the description of the study programme or the Specific Requirements, an Applicant must submit a copy of an official certificate (IELTS Academic 6.5+, TOEFL iBT 81+, Cambridge English Exam 176+, Pearson PTE Academic 59+, LanguageCert IESOL B2, Duolingo English Test 120+, Password Skills Plus 6.5+) certifying language proficiency level (no lower than B2 following the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)). This requirement shall not be applicable if the language of instruction in the chosen study programme is the Applicant's native language or the Applicant is a national of a state with the same official language, or the Applicant's previously acquired education had the same language of instruction.

3.2 In the event of other languages of instruction in the chosen study programme, the Applicant must submit a document issued by a competent institution (higher education institution, testing centre, etc.) certifying the proficiency level in the required foreign language provided in the Specific Requirements.

4. Applicants to the first cycle and integrated study programmes of the University must provide documents certifying the completion of secondary education and meet the specific requirements of the chosen programme. The table provides only specific requirements for admission to first cycle and integrated study programmes with the language of instruction other than Lithuanian:

The deadlines for submitting applications shall be approved by the Pro-Rector for Studies of Vilnius University (hereinafter the ‘University’) upon proposal from the Student Admissions Subdivision of the Study Quality and Development Division of the University’s Central Administration, and they shall be published on the University’s website (<https://www.vu.lt/en>).
2. The deadlines for submitting applications by Applicants:
 - 2.1. for the autumn semester (studies starting on 1 September):
 - 2.1.1. by 1 May – for non-EU (non-European Union)/non-EFTA (non-European Free Trade Association) nationals;
 - 2.1.2. by 1 July – for EU/EFTA nationals; non-EU/non-EFTA nationals who are subject to a visa-free 90-day regime in the EU.
 - 2.2. the deadlines for submitting documents and for selecting applicants to joint study programmes shall be established by a separate agreement between the partners of the study programme and published on the website of the University.
