The objective

An understanding of the principles, concepts, policies and practicalities at the leading edge of managing progressive health systems and its relevance to broader public policy agendas, health entrepreneurship and its relevance to science to science and technology based business. Students participate in international European universities at up to four consortium universities (in Spain, Hungary, Lithuania and Italy).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants must meet the following admission criteria:

 A university degree in Sociology, Psychology, Law, Political Science, Anthropology, History, Medicine, Social Work, Social Education, Nursing, Public Health, etc. • Adequate knowledge of English (demonstrated by TOEFL, First Certificate, or IELTS).

Applicants must include the following documents:

- Academic credentials, with copy of Diploma and, if available, Diploma Supplement
- Certified copies of academic transcripts
- Academic or professional CV
- Letter of motivation (stating why the Master's is relevant for future career)
- 3 passport-sized photos, photocopy of a valid passport
- 2 reference letters
- Copies of language tests scores and language certificates (TOEFL/IELTS, etc.) or an official letter from your University stating, that studies were in English
