### 3. 초청학생 유의사항

1) 자가격리: 해외 입국자의 경우 현재 2주(14일) 동안 자가격리를 해야하며, 자가격리가 필수인 경우 학생이 직접 자가격리 장소를 확보하고 비용을 부담해야 함
