Sewha Hall opened as an on-campus housing community in early 2005. It has a capacity of welcoming 434 both Korean and international students. Each room is double occupancy, equipped with a bathroom, air conditioning, beds, wardrobes, bookshelves and desks. The room also has a mini-fridge and a sink. Shared facilities include study rooms, seminar rooms, student lounges, laundry rooms, a convenience store and a fitness center.
