Description:	Founded in Guangzhou in 1888 and re-established in Hong Kong in 1967, Lingnan University aspires to become a leading Asian liberal arts university with international recognition, distinguished by outstanding teaching, learning, scholarship and community engagement. Lingnan University takes pride in the provision of quality whole-person education by combining the best of Chinese and Western liberal arts traditions; a combination of liberal arts with specialised disciplinary education; and an optimal balance between teaching and research. With three Faculties (i.e. Arts, Business and Social Sciences) and a growing Science Unit, the University is committed to providing students with a unique liberal arts education, which is characterised by a broad and interdisciplinary curriculum, small classes, a vibrant residential campus, and abundant global learning opportunities. Course Restrictions:	Basically none; Exchange students are welcome to take any undergraduate courses from across the curriculum. However, some courses have pre-requisite requirements / major restrictions, prospective students are strongly advised to seek advice from their academic advisers.

Each applicant is required to pay an amount of HK\$470, covering the non-refundable fee for student visa application (HK\$230) and the postage (around HK\$240).

Fees and Expenses:	• Exchange students are normally required to pay tuition fee to their home institution

	and the respective home institutions. For students who are required to pay
	accommodation fee to Lingnan, the fee is approximately HK\$6,540 per regular term or HK\$2,236 for Session 1, Summer Term and HK\$1,300 for Session 2, Summer Term.
	 All exchange students are required to take care of the utility expenses, air-conditioning
	charges, at HK\$330 per regular term, HK\$220 for Session 1, Summer Term and HK\$130 for
	Session 2, Summer Term.
	Other expenses (board, books, transportation, miscellaneous) are the responsibility of the
	students.
Housing & Meals:	• Exchange students are required to live on campus and share room with a non-exchange
	student during the entire period of study at Lingnan. All the rooms are on twin-sharing
	basis and are generally sex-segregated on each floor. Exchange students will live in a
	residence hall with Lingnan students.
	• The University DOES NOT OPERATE any meal plan, mandatory or optional. There is a
	student cafeteria and a full service Chinese restaurant on campus that provides a variety
	of inexpensive meals. There are also many restaurants in the neighborhood off campus.
Insurance:	Mandatory: Students must have appropriate and adequate insurance covering travel, personal
	accident, medical expenses (accident and non-accident), hospitalization and emergency
	evacuation / repatriation throughout the study period at Lingnan.
