Travel:

• City buses **No. 3G** and **No. 88** provide services from the airport to the city centre. The fares and schedule can be found at https://www.stops.lt/vilnius/#vilnius/en

3G - route "Oro uostas (Airport) - Centras(Center) - Fabijoniškės (Stops: J.Tumo -Vaizganto, next to Gediminas ave.)
88 - route "Oro uostas (Airport) - Stotis(bus/train station) - Senamiestis (Old town) - Nepriklausomybės aikštė (Squre of Independence)



VU apartments (Čiurlionio str. ½) - bus **3G** – route stops: "**Oro uostas (get in)** – Dariaus ir Girėno – Naujininkai- Sparta – Taraso Ševčenkos- **Čiurlionio (get off)**, turn round the corner and go forward.

Single ticket – 1 EUR, you can buy it from the driver.
