IntBaltCan International Baltic Summer School in Canadian Studies: Rethinking Canada

Latvia Riga, Ventspils 10 July – 17 July, 2018

A joint initiative of the Centre for Applied Linguistics at the University of Latvia, the Latvian Association for Canadian studies and Ventspils University College

We welcome students interested in Canadian studies to participate in the first International Baltic Summer School in Canadian studies which introduces major themes and events of Canadian history by exploring the socio-political domain and examining literary texts and visual and popular culture of Canada. The Summer school adopts a multi-disciplinary approach and is organized into four modules:

The module 'Cultural dimensions of Canadian Identity' is delivered in English and French.

- ✓ Curriculum Vitae;
- ✓ letter of motivation (a personal statement);
- ✓ language proficiency statement (*English/French*)

PARTICIPATION FEE

<u>The tuition fee</u> - covers Summer school classes and study materials and is set at **160EUR** The study fee **does not cover** accommodation, meals, transfer Riga-Ventspils-Riga.

ACCOMMODATION

Summer school attendees are accommodated at

• the University of Latvia Dormitories in Riga (detailed information is available on the website of the University of Latvia https://www.lu.lv/eng/istudents/accommodation/):

Hostel (Riga, Reznas street 10C):

a single bed (common kitchen area and a shared bathroom):

- in a triple room € 5.00 per night
- in a double room € 8.00 per night
- and Ventspils University College Dormitories in Ventspils;

The hostel consists of blocks – there are two rooms, one shower and a toilet in every block. There is furniture in every room: a wardrobe, a bookshelf, chairs, a table and of course a bed. It is possible to connect to the wireless Internet as well as to use a cable. There is a kitchen for every five blocks and there is a café on the 6th floor.

- a single bed in a block with four other tenants, two per each room of the block is \notin 9.00 per night

TRANSFER RIGA-VENTSPILS-RIGA
