AEN – Network of Universities in Australia:

Students from any field of study can apply bachelor and master level only: (list of participating Universities is available at <u>http://www.aen-online.com/</u>)



MAUI – Network of Universities in the USA

Students from any field of study can apply: <u>http://www.midamericauniversities.org/</u>

AEN and MAUI will:

- 1. Provide tuition free studies
- 2. Assist in finding suitable accommodation

Exchange student will have to cover:

- 1. Travel and accommodation expenses
- 2. Health insurance expenses
- 3. Passport and visa fees
- 4. Other personal expenses

The following steps need to be taken in order to apply:

<u>Stage I Internal Selection</u>: Students who wish to participate in the exchange have to submit a list of 3 universities in order of priority and motivation letter till **February 14th through online application**.

NB: It is important to note that students have to provide a list of <u>three</u> Universities for their application to be considered.

NB: Students can apply only to AEN or MAUI network; they cannot apply to both networks simultaneously.

<u>Stage II:</u> Internal selection results and nomination to a specific network.

<u>Stage III: Application to a specific University</u>. The following documents have to be filled in when the results of *Stage II* are announced in March-April:

- 1. Application Form of the University where you were selected for your exchange studies
- 2. Transcript of Records in English
- 3. Learning agreement with signature with faculty coordinator
- 4. TOEFL/IELTS or other exam results
- 5. Passport copy

Document package can vary depending on particular University requirements.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Spring semester – **February 14th** (for next year) Fall semester – **February 14th**
