

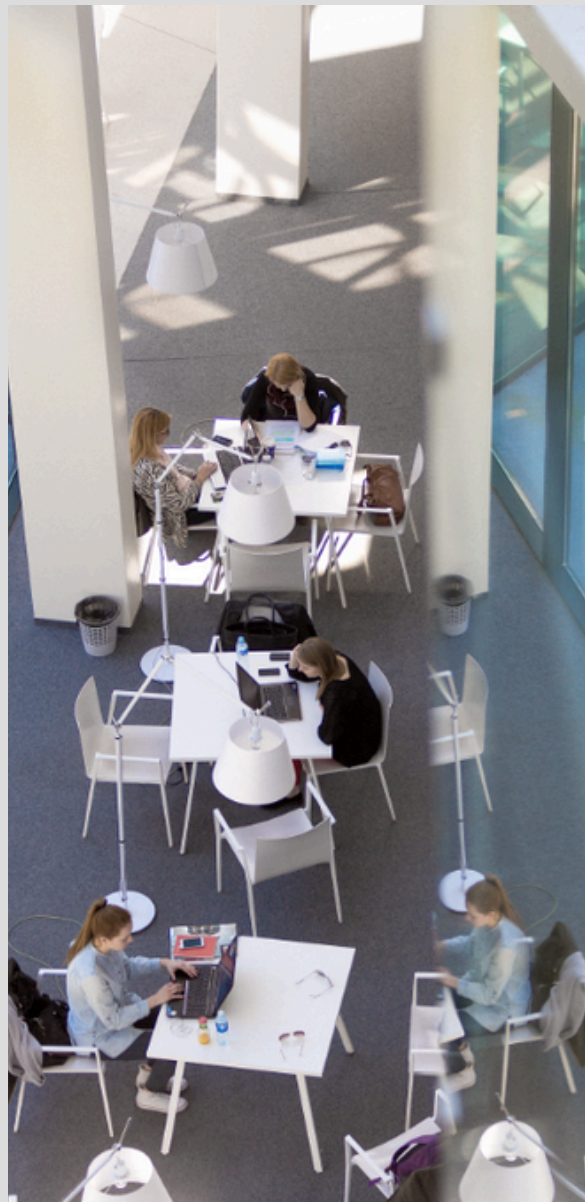

SCHOLARSHIP FOR FUTURE STUDENTS FROM SOCIALLY SENSITIVE BACKGROUND

Vilnius University is the only university in Lithuania that awards scholarships to applicants from socially vulnerable groups before the start of their studies to encourage them to pursue education (450th anniversary scholarships).

DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The applicant receives the confirmation about the awarded scholarship together with the invitation to study at VU

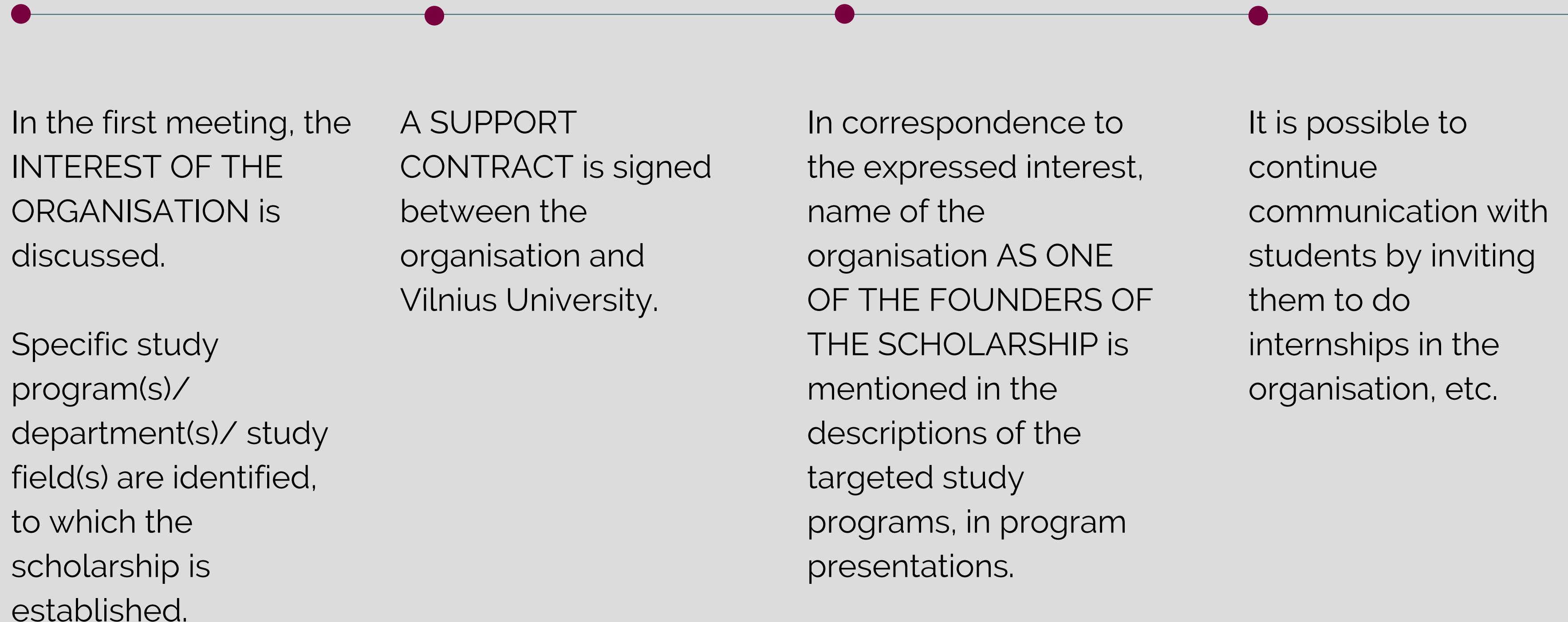
Students who have applied for a scholarship are asked to prove that they meet set requirements

The scholarship is paid for 10 months – 300 euros each

The size of the scholarship for one student is 3000 euros



COOPERATION PROCESS



INFORMATION ABOUT 2023

>4700 students entered VU

>500 applications were submitted for the 450th anniversary scholarships

>3000 students, who moved to Vilnius after the enrolment at VU

116 students received scholarships

The purpose of the scholarship is to reduce the problem of social exclusion in Lithuania, to increase the accessibility of university education and to help first-year students from socially sensitive groups, enrolled at the University's Bachelor and integrated studies, adapt to the new environment.
