

RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF VILNIUS UNIVERSITY

ON AWARDING MAGNA CUM LAUDE DIPLOMAS AT VILNIUS UNIVERSITY

In accordance with Article 33(1)(32) of the Statute of Vilnius University, the Criteria for Awarding *Cum Laude* and *Magna Cum Laude* Diplomas at Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. S-2015-9-2 of 24 November 2015 "On the Approval of the Criteria for Awarding *Cum Laude* and *Magna Cum Laude* Diplomas" (wording of Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-38 of 22 June 2021), and Items 89 and 90 of the Study Regulations of Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-43 of 21 June 2022 "On the Approval of the Study Regulations of Vilnius University and on the Amendments and Repeal of Certain Resolutions of a Senate Commission of Vilnius University", and taking into account Proposal of the Rector of Vilnius University No. RTK-28 of 18 May 2023 "On Issuing *Magna Cum Laude* Vilnius University Diplomas", the proposals of the heads of core academic units of Vilnius University on issuing *Magna Cum Laude* Vilnius University diplomas, and Resolution of the Studies Affairs Committee of Vilnius University Senate of 16 May 2023 (Minutes No. (1.8 E) 11500-KT-228), the Senate of Vilnius University hereby decides:
