OF THE SENATE  
OF VILNIUS UNIVERSITY**

**ON THE SUBMISSION OF RESEARCH PAPERS TO THE 2022 COMPETITION FOR  
THE NOMINAL PRIZE OF MEILĖ LUKŠIENĖ OF THE LITHUANIAN ACADEMY OF  
SCIENCES**

In accordance with Article 33(1)(32) of the Statute of Vilnius University and Item 9 the Regulations for Awarding the Prize of Meilė Lukšienė, approved by Resolution of the Presidium of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences No. 24 of 8 May 2018 (wording of Resolution of the Presidium of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences No. 23 of 5 July 2022), taking into account Letter of the Vice-Dean of the Faculty of History of Vilnius University No. (1.4 E) 170000-V-50 of 5 September 2022, Resolution of the Council of the Faculty of Philosophy of Vilnius University of 15 September 2022 (Minutes No. 250000-TP-7) and Resolution of the Council of the Faculty of Mathematics and Informatics of Vilnius University No. (1.5 E) 110000-TPN-21 of 19 September 2022, the Senate of Vilnius University hereby decides
