Report on the Implementation of the Revenue and Expenditure Estimate of Vilnius University for 2021

On 27 January 2021, the Council of Vilnius University approved the revenue and expenditure estimate of Vilnius University (hereinafter the 'University') for 2021 (Resolution No. TPN-1). According to the approved estimate, the University anticipated earning 114.53 million EUR in revenue, incurring 111.50 million EUR in expenses, and acquiring fixed assets for 3.46 million EUR. The table on the implementation of the estimate is provided in Annex 1.

Overview

In 2021, the University's revenue surplus, excluding depreciation of fixed assets, amounted to 12,440 thousand EUR and was 9,415 thousand EUR higher than anticipated. The net result, including the acquisition of fixed assets, amounted to 9,349 thousand EUR and was 9,785 thousand EUR greater than expected. The summary of the Report on the Implementation of the Revenue and Expenditure Estimate of the University for 2021 is provided in Table 1.

The COVID-19 pandemic still exerted its influence on the University's financial situation. The effect on the revenue was minor but the costs of travelling, secondments, organising conferences, etc. were approx. 1 million EUR lower than planned. The other revenue of core academic units was higher than anticipated, e.g. that of the Life Sciences Center was higher by approx. 1,4 million EUR and, due to commissioned work carried out at the Faculty of History, it was greater by 702 thousand EUR, whereas the remuneration and other costs amounted to 94 thousand EUR and 580 thousand EUR respectively. The fixed asset repair costs were higher mostly due to the repair of the University's architectural ensemble buildings (estimated at approx. 2 million EUR), which was carried out in 2021, and the funding for which was received in 2020.

Revenue

The state budget appropriations received in 2021 totalled 94,251 thousand EUR, whereas the anticipated amount, as specified in the revenue and expenditure estimate, was 91,225 thousand EUR. A detailed breakdown of the received state budget appropriations is provided in Table 2.

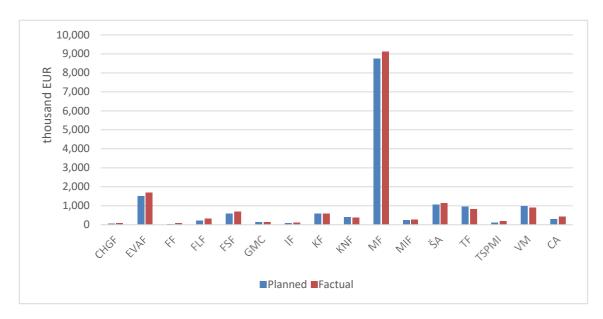


Figure 1. Distribution of the revenue from studies in 2021.

The revenue from studies generated in 2021 amounted to 17,058 thousand EUR, which was 956 thousand EUR higher than anticipated. The distribution of revenue among the University's units and the implementation of their plans is illustrated in Figure 1.

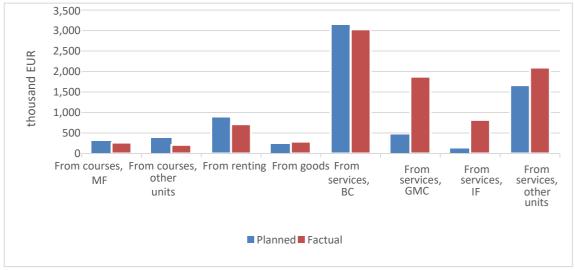


Figure 2. Other revenue in 2021.

The revenue of other types generated in 2021 amounted to 9,311 thousand EUR, which was 2,108 thousand EUR higher than expected. A detailed breakdown of the other revenue is presented in Figure 2.

Compared to 2020, the used funding (excluding the used funding related to the depreciation of fixed assets) and the other revenue from all sources of funds increased by 26,310 thousand EUR, i.e. by 19.8 per cent. In addition to the rise in funding for studies and research, it was also influenced by the incorporation of Šiauliai University (approx. 2.7 million EUR from state budget appropriations, approx. 1.5 million EUR from own funds revenue, and approx. 1 million EUR from endowment funds).

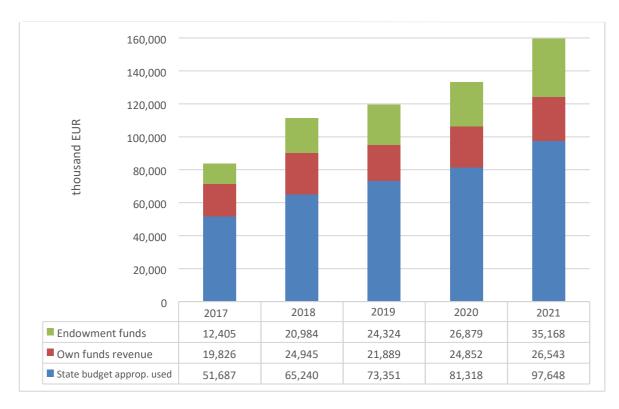


Figure 3. Funding and other revenue from all sources of funds used in 2017–2021.

Costs

In 2021, the amount planned for remuneration and related costs was 82,266 thousand EUR, while the actually incurred costs reached 83,557 thousand EUR (exceeding the planned amount by 1,291 thousand EUR). Remuneration for researchers, junior researchers, assistant professors, teaching assistants, and lecturers was increased as of 1 May 2021. In 2021, the leave reserve was raised by 391 thousand EUR and the pension reserve was increased by 124 thousand EUR.

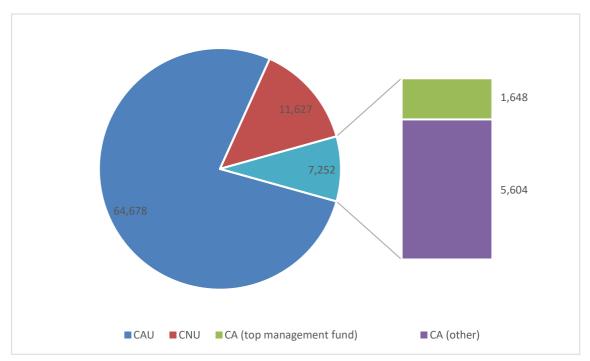


Figure 4. Distribution of actual remuneration and related costs in 2021 (in thousand EUR).

The distribution of remuneration and related costs among core academic units, core non-academic units, and the Central Administration is presented in Figure 4.

Premiums paid out at academic units amounted to 5,603 thousand EUR (of which 4,522 thousand EUR was paid to the academic staff, and 1,081 thousand EUR to the non-academic staff), while the planned amount of premiums for academic units was 5,026 thousand EUR (of which 4,364 thousand EUR was allocated to the academic staff, and 662 thousand EUR to the non-academic staff).

A breakdown of remuneration costs paid out at academic units in 2021 (excluding internal reallocations and changes in leave and pension reserves) is provided in Table 4.

In 2021, the utility costs incurred were 528 thousand EUR higher than anticipated. In the second half of the year, electricity prices grew significantly. Heating prices also increased but the rise in prices was compensated by lower-than-planned consumption.

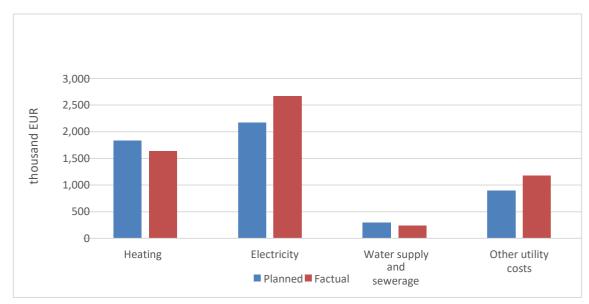


Figure 5. Detailed breakdown of utility costs in 2021.

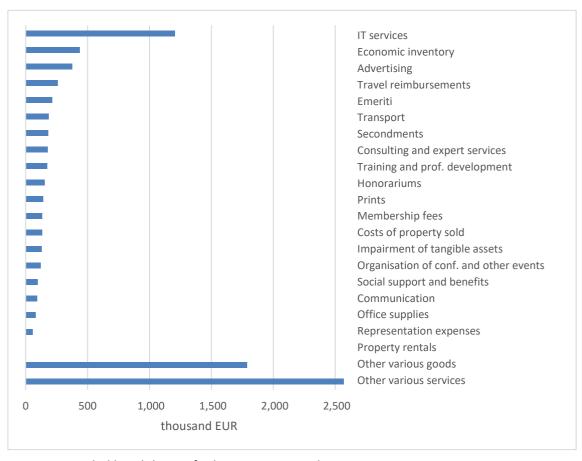


Figure 6. Detailed breakdown of other costs incurred in 2021.

Financial and investment activity costs included the following: transferred funding amounting to 334 thousand EUR, exchange rate changes amounting to 78 thousand EUR, interest costs amounting to 65 thousand EUR, and the impairment on receivables of 135 thousand EUR.

In 2021, 4,681 thousand EUR was allocated to strategic initiatives (excluding funds for raising remuneration for the non-academic staff), while 1,755 thousand EUR was factually used. Out of 1,588 thousand EUR allocated for investment, 1,283 thousand EUR was used.

When drawing up the revenue and expenditure estimate of the University, it was assumed that the level of overheads of endowment funds would be around 1,200 thousand EUR. The factual involvement in project activities was higher and, thus, overhead expenses amounted to 1,652 thousand EUR. Although these expenses are not directly reflected in the Report on the Implementation of the Revenue and Expenditure Estimate of the University for 2021, they led to a decline in own funds expenditures, as their major part was paid out using endowment funds.

Result breakdown by units

A breakdown of the net result by unit groups is presented below:
