**IMPROVEMENT** by creating an enabling environment with a commitment to excellence, growth, and acceptance of those willing to improve, as well as to achieve exceptional value.




**LONG-TERM PURPOSE** stemming from a prospective foresight as a responsibility to the state and society, culture, and environment.


