



**RESOLUTION  
OF THE SENATE  
OF VILNIUS UNIVERSITY**

**ON AWARDING *MAGNA CUM LAUDE* VILNIUS UNIVERSITY DIPLOMAS**

No. SPN-25 of 19 May 2026

In accordance with Article 33(1)(32) of the Statute of Vilnius University, the Criteria for Awarding *Cum Laude* and *Magna Cum Laude* Diplomas at Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. S-2015-9-2 of 24 November 2015 “On the Approval of the Criteria for Awarding *Cum Laude* and *Magna Cum Laude* Diplomas” (wording of Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-36 of 21 May 2024), and Items 90 and 91 of the Study Regulations of Vilnius University, approved by Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-43 of 21 June 2022 “On the Approval of the Study Regulations of Vilnius University and on the Amendments and Repeal of Certain Resolutions of a Senate Commission of Vilnius University” (wording of Resolution of the Senate of Vilnius University No. SPN-12 of 29 April 2025), and taking into account Proposal from the Rector of Vilnius University No. RTK-38 of 14 May 2026 “On Awarding *Magna Cum Laude* Vilnius University Diplomas”, Proposals from the heads of core academic units of Vilnius University on awarding *Magna Cum Laude* Vilnius University diplomas, and Resolution of the Studies Affairs Committee of Vilnius University Senate of 5 May 2026 (Minutes No. 1.1.3 Mr-10000-KT-1772), the Senate of Vilnius University hereby decides:
